Before you apply to serve, carefully consider what it entails. A team is made up of members of the Christian community who witness to Pilgrims in talks, table discussions and service. Participation in Fourth Day activities enhances this ability. Team members then can pass on the message of the Pilgrimage experience included in the guidelines of the National Council of Presbyterian Fourth Day Movements.

Staff members support the weekend in the following ways:

- **Serve when called** (both on the weekend and training dates). This indicates that you will be able and willing to serve in the capacity the Moderator feels is best for you and the team.
- **Meet the required time commitment** by attending staff training and preparation. Training will be held in February or March 2019 (TBD) at a Florida location. All staff members are expected to attend!
- **Meet the financial responsibility** of a staff member: \$300. **A deposit of \$50 is requested**
- **Recruit Pilgrims to attend** and encourage them to complete and send in a Pilgrim's Application and help them secure a Sponsor.
- **Make Palanca and pray** for the weekend.

If, after prayerful consideration, you feel called to serve on staff, please complete the application and return it to the moderator as soon as possible and no later than January 15, 2019 for planning purposes. After that date, applications will be considered if an opening remains.
