Team members then can pass on the message of the Pilgrimage experience included in the guidelines of the National Council of Presbyterian Fourth Day Movements.

- Serve when called (both on the weekend and on training dates). This indicates that you will be able and willing to serve in the capacity the Moderator feels is best for you and the team.
- Meet the required time commitment by attending staff training and preparation.

 March 9, 2024: An optional breakfast will be served at 8:00 am. Training will be held in the Neumann Center of the First Presbyterian Church of Ft. Lauderdale, 451 Tarpon Drive, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301 between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. All staff/team members are expected to attend the training!
- Meet the financial responsibility of a staff member: \$325.00. A deposit of \$50 is required.
- **Recruit Pilgrims to attend** and encourage them to complete and send in a Pilgrim's Application and help them secure a Shepherd.
- Make palanca and pray for the weekend.
